I am thankful for Habitat coming into my life. My parents told me a house was being built in Wild Rose and I should apply. I was trying to buy a house in

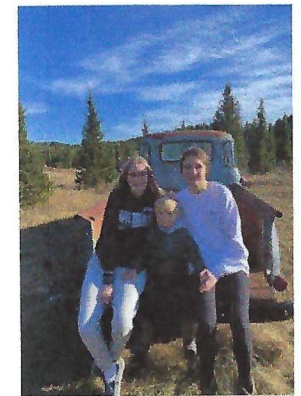
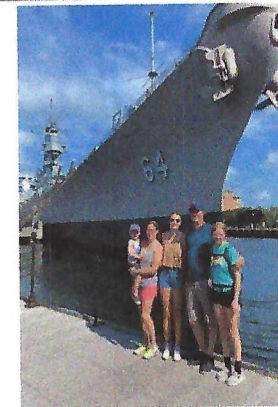
